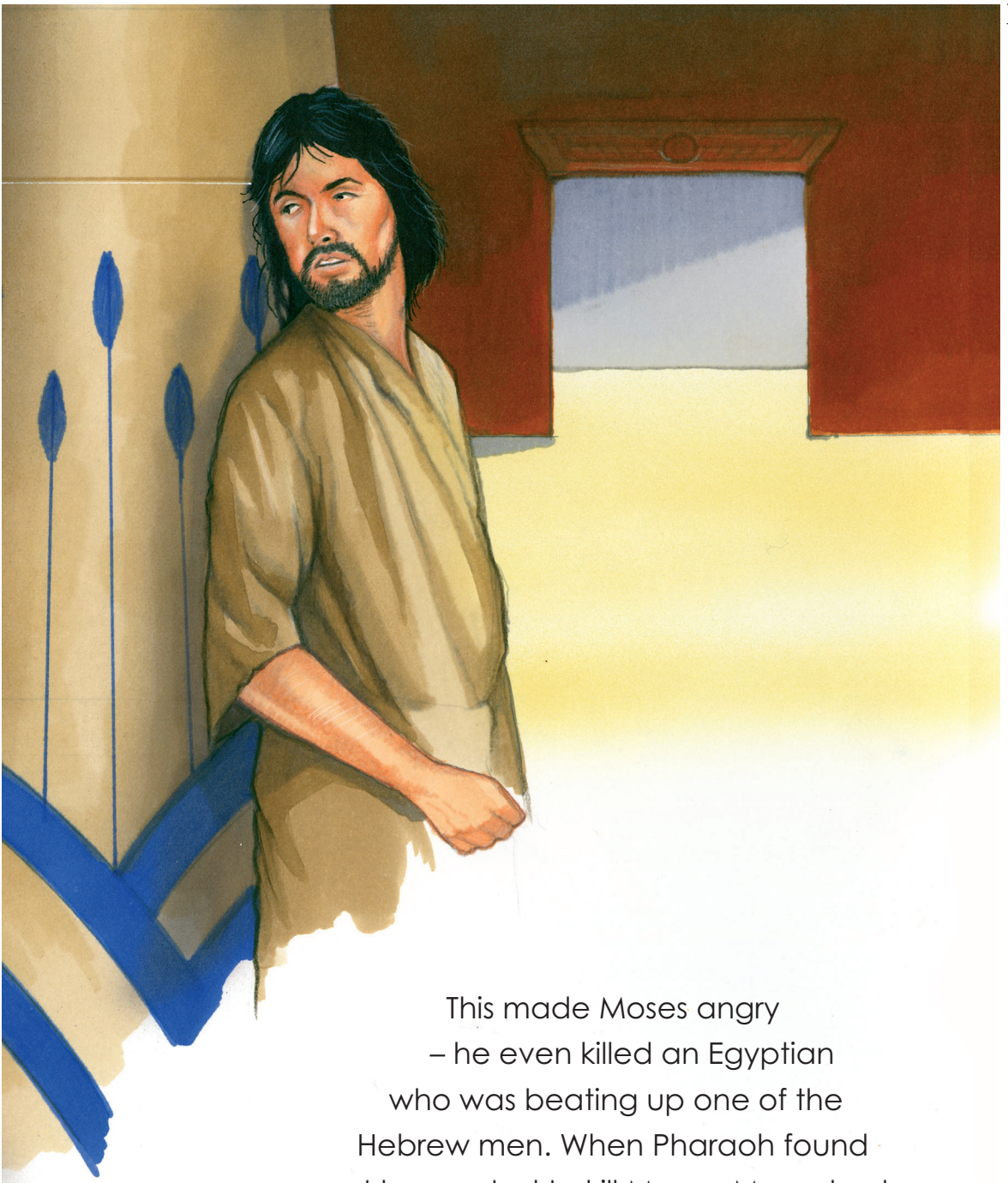




Moses was a Hebrew by birth but had been adopted by the Egyptian princess, the daughter of Pharaoh. His people were slaves in Egypt.
